The 21st International Conference of Hong Kong Society for Transportation Studies (HKSTS) was successfully held from 10-12 December 2016 at the InterContinental Grand Stanford Hong Kong. The theme of this year's conference is "Smart Transportation" which covers topics related to Intelligent Transportation System; Transportation Infrastructure and Built Environment; Sustainability Issues in Transportation; Transportation Surveys; Travel Behavior Modelling; Technology and Information; Transport Geography; Transport Dynamics; Logistics and Supply Chain Management; and Transport Networks. The conference offers an excellent platform to elevate the insights on the design, analysis, planning, operation, co-ordination and management of transportation projects together with their impacts.

The conference has drawn near 240 submissions from researchers across five continents. After a vigorous review process, over 120 papers were accepted for presentation at the conference covering the full spectrum of research topics. It attracted near 200 participants from all over the world, including Australia, Canada, China, Denmark, France, Germany, Hong Kong, India, Japan, Macau, Singapore, South Korea, Sweden, Taiwan, Thailand, The Netherlands, U.K. and U.S.A. The annual conference of HKSTS becomes an international event for exchanging and archiving knowledge on the development of advanced transportation research.

To foster excellence in transportation research and practice of students, our Society has established the HKSTS Outstanding Student Paper Award. The winning paper was "Optimal Fare Structure and Frequency for Transit Networks with Elastic Demand" by Ms. Sujun SUN of The University of Hong Kong. There was one first runner-up paper this year: "Modeling Household Residential and Car Ownership Decisions: Group Decision Based Time Allocation Approach" by Ms. Mingzhu YAO of Hong Kong Baptist University.
