




- Please go to the paper management system for HKSTS 2018: https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=hksts2018. If you already have an EasyChair account from other conferences, please go to Step 3 directly. Otherwise, please proceed to Step 2 for account setup.
- 2. Account Setup (only for those who do not have an EasyChair account):
 - 2.1. Click "create an account" to register an account.




2.2. Click "I'm not a robot", and then click "Continue".




2.3. Fill in your name and email address. Then click "Continue".




2.4. You will receive a confirmation email from EasyChair. Please click the provided link to proceed with the registration process.






3.11. After a final check, if all the required information is correct, click "Submit" to finish the abstract submission procedure.
