### **Seat-in-coach Tours Information**

### 1. Hong Kong Island Tour

More interesting sceneries along this Western shoreline of Hong Kong are the skyscrapers built on the hillside, traditional shipyards, the high-skill Tuen Mun Highway and the World's largest Container Terminal, all vividly contrasting, but in great harmony.
